

Recreation Happenings (Fort Fairfield)

Ice Skating Outing-The parks and recreation department is sponsoring a field trip to the Forum for free ice skating on Monday, December 28 from 1:00-3:00pm. The bus will depart from the Community Center at 12:30pm and return at approximately 3:30pm. Participants must be at least nine years of age to attend or be accompanied on the bus by a responsible chaperone. Registration forms are available at school or the community center and must be filled out and returned prior to the date of the trip.

Roller Skating Outing-The parks and recreation department is sponsoring a field trip to the Melody Roller Rink in Caribou on Wednesday, December 30 from 1:00-3:00pm. The bus will depart from the Community Center at 12:30pm and return at approximately 3:30pm. The cost is \$5 per person. As with all our field trips, participants must be at least nine years of age to attend or be accompanied by a responsible chaperone. Registration forms are available at school or the community center and must be filled out and returned prior to the date of the trip.

Candlepin Bowling Outing-The parks and recreation department is sponsoring a field trip to Northern Lanes in Presque Isle to go bowling on Thursday, December 31 from 10:00-11:30am. The bus will depart from the community center at 9:30am and will return at approximately 12:00 noon. The cost is \$5 per person to attend and includes transportation, bowling shoes, and bowling for over an hour. Participants must be at least nine years of age to attend or be accompanied by a responsible chaperone. Registration forms are available at the community center or at school and must be filled out and returned prior to the date of the trip.

Free Skating at the Forum-Fort Fairfield residents can skate for free at the Forum in Presque Isle beginning Thursday, December 24 and continue through Sunday, February 21, 2016 (end of February school vacation). In order to gain access to the Forum for free skating, each Fort Fairfield resident must present picture identification at the ticket window that includes proof of residency. Pee-Wee Basketball-Pee Wee Basketball for boys and girls in grades 1-3 has just begun and is currently being held at the Fort Fairfield Community Center on Saturdays and Tuesday evenings and will continue through February 6. There is no fee to participate and you can still register your child for the program by contacting the parks and recreation department at 472-3882.

Youth Basketball-Youth Basketball for boys and girls in grades 4-6 has just gotten underway at the Fort Fairfield Community Center and is being held on Saturdays and Wednesday evenings and will continue through February 6. There is no fee to participate and you can still register your child by contacting the parks and recreation department at 472-3882.

Youth Travel Basketball Teams-Boys and girls in grades 4-6 who are participating in the Fort Fairfield Youth Basketball program will have an opportunity to play on the boys or girls travel basketball teams that represent our department and will play approximately 14 games with

other recreation teams from throughout Aroostook County during the 2015-16 season. There is no charge to participate on the travel teams. All players enrolled in the youth basketball program will receive more information regarding the recreation travel teams including when the first practices will be held. The travel teams are scheduled to start playing games the middle of January and will continue playing through the beginning of March with the season ending at the Girls County Tournament in Fort Fairfield or the Boys County Tournament in Caribou.

Adult Basketball-Adult basketball is being played on Monday and Thursday evenings at the Fort Fairfield Community Center Gymnasium from 6:30-8:30pm. Play is informal with teams being selected each night from all those in attendance.

Adult Volleyball-Adult Co-ed Volleyball is held every Sunday evening at the Fort Fairfield Community Center from 6:00-8:00pm. The program is for individuals high school age and over with play being informal and teams being selected each night from all those in attendance. There is no charge to play. Indoor Walking Running, and Exercise-The Fort Fairfield Community Center gymnasium and exercise area are open to the public for walking, running, and exercise Monday through Friday from 6:00am-12:00noon (except holidays). The hours are subject to change occasionally and will be posted accordingly. There is no charge to participate.

Cross-Country Ski Rentals-The parks and recreation department is renting out cross-country ski packages again this winter to boys and girls in grades 2-8. The cost to rent a complete package for the entire ski season is \$25 for the first family member and \$20 for each additional child in the family. Contact the parks and recreation department (472-3882) to make an appointment to pick up your ski package for the season.

Youth Cross Country Ski Program-The parks and recreation department will be conducting an after school cross-country ski program again this winter for boys and girls in grades 2-6 beginning on Thursday, January 28 and ending when the snow is gone at winters end. The youth ski program will be held on Thursday afternoons from 3:00-4:15pm. Skiers will meet in the Fort Fairfield Elementary School cafeteria directly after school. Participants will be taught the basics of cross-country skiing, proper ski care, and all sorts of fun ski games and activities. The kids will also ski at the Nordic Heritage Center occasionally to experience the fantastic trails and opportunities of this great facility. There is no charge to participate.

NHSC Saturday Morning Kids Ski Club-The Nordic Heritage Sport Club will be conducting a Saturday morning cross-country ski program for kids again this winter which will be starting the middle of January and continue through the end of March. More detailed information regarding the program should be available on the Nordic Heritage Sport Club web site.

Open Gymnasium-The Fort Fairfield Community Center Gymnasium and game room are open to the public for free play on Saturday afternoons from 1:00-4:00pm and Sunday afternoons from 12:00-4:00pm. The game room is open for students Monday through Friday after school from 3:00-5:00pm. During school vacations, holidays, and early school release days the facility

will be open to the public for free play from 12:00-4:00pm. These hours for open play are subject to change occasionally due to other scheduled activities and special events.

AYBL Basketball Grades 7 & 8-There will be a 7th and 8th grade boys team and girls team from Fort Fairfield playing in the Aroostook Youth Basketball League this winter. Practice will begin sometime the week of January 11. More information regarding the AYBL teams from Fort Fairfield will be available soon.

Indoor Soccer-Indoor Soccer for boys and girls in grades 2-8 will be held on Tuesday and Friday afternoons at the community center beginning on Tuesday, March 1 and ending on Friday, April 15. The program is co-ed with grades 2-3 playing from 3:00-4:00pm; grades 4-5 playing from 4:00-5:00pm; and grades 6-8 playing from 5:00-6:00pm. More information regarding the indoor soccer program will be forthcoming at a later date.
