

Fort Fairfield Parks and Recreation Department February Vacation Activities

Ski at Big Rock Mountain-The Northern Maine Community Recreation Association is participating in Recreation Department Ski Day at Big Rock Mountain on Friday, February 19. Fort Fairfield Parks and Recreation Department is participating in this fun day of skiing at Big Rock and is promoting this activity to all residents of Fort Fairfield. Skiers from participating communities (including Fort Fairfield) can ski at Big Rock on February 19 from 11:00am to 8:00pm for only \$15. If you need ski rental equipment for the day, an additional \$15 will get you fully equipped at the Big Rock Rental Shop (please arrive a little early if you need to rent equipment). **If you are under the age of 18 and want to rent ski equipment at Big Rock for the day you need to bring a Big Rock ski rental form signed by your parents or guardians (forms are available at the Fort Fairfield Parks and Recreation Department or the Fort Fairfield Town Office).** Transportation to and from the Mountain for the day is on your own. If you can't find a ride, please contact the Fort Fairfield Parks and Recreation Department and we will try and arrange a ride for you. **In order to participate and get the reduced rate pricing of \$15, you must sign up ahead of time through the Parks and Recreation Department either in person or by calling 472-3882 and let us know that you plan to attend so that we can inform Big Rock.**

Ski at Nordic Heritage Center-On Thursday, February 18 the Fort Fairfield Youth Cross-Country Ski Program will be held at the Nordic Heritage Center from 1:00-3:00pm. All the boys and girls in grades 2-5 who are currently enrolled in the youth ski program are welcome to attend along with any members of the Fort Fairfield Middle School Ski Team. We will cruise the same trails that the World Cup Biathletes compete on at the World Cup Biathlon event. The bus departs from the Community Center at 1:00pm and returns approximately 3:00pm. There is no cost to participate in open gym and all students are welcome.

Hot Shot Regional Basketball Competition-On Wednesday, February 17 the boys and girls ages 9-18 who qualified at the local Hot Shot Qualifier in Fort Fairfield will compete in the Northern Maine Regional Hot Shot Competition at the Caribou Recreation Center. Boys and girls in the 9-10 year old age group will shoot starting at 10:00am (please check in at the registration table between 9:00 and 10:00am). All other age groups (11-12, 13-15, and 16-18) will shoot starting at approximately 11:00am. Transportation to and from the competition is on your own.
