The Owner Hereby Agrees To:

1. Provide. Erect and maintain all necessary barricades, lights, warning signs and other devices to safeguard traffic properly while the work is in progress.
2. At NO time cause the roadway to be closed to traffic.
3. When the driveway/entrance is located within a curb, curb and gutter, and/or sidewalk section, completely remove the existing curb and gutter, and/or sidewalk as may be required to create the driveway/entrance and restore drainage. All driveways/entrances abutting sidewalk sections shall meet the requirements set forth in the Americans with disabilities Act of 1990.
4. Obtain, deliver to site and install any culverts and/or drainage structures necessary for drainage; the size, type and length of such culverts or structures shall be specified in the permit pursuant to 23 M.R.S.A. # 705.
5. Complete construction of proposed driveway/entrance within twelve months of construction.
6. Comply with all applicable federal, state and municipal regulations and ordinances.
7. Not alter, without the express written consent of the Town of Fort Fairfield, any culverts or drainage swales within the Town's right-of-way.
8. Notify the Town of Fort Fairfield of a proposed change of use served by driveway/entrance when increase in traffic flow is expected to occur.

FURTHER CONDITION OF THE PERMIT:

The Owner shall assume the defense of, and pay all damages, fines, and penalties for which he/she shall become liable, and shall indemnify and save harmless said Town of Fort Fairfield, its representatives, agents and employees from liability, actions, against all suits, claims, damages for wrongful death, personal injuries or property damage suffered by any person or association which results from the willful or negligent action or inaction of the owner/applicant/agent and in proceedings of every kind arising out of the construction and maintenance of said entrance(s)m including snow removal. Nothing herein shall, nor is intended to, waiver and defense, immunity of liability which may be available to the Town of Fort Fairfield, their officers, agents or employees under the Maine Tort Claims Act or any other privileges and/or immunities provided by law.
