The Town of Fort Fairfield is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Captain with the Fire Rescue Department. This hiring notice will be used to select and hire three (3) candidates for the position of Captain through a phased hiring process. These are front line, shift supervisor positions that will be responsible for the daily management of both Career and Paid-call staff and will report to the Deputy Fire Chief. Upon acceptance of a position, the applicant will be considered an "Acting Captain" for a period of six months. Upon successful completion of this probation period the promotion will be finalized and the employee will move to full Captains pay.
